



COVID-19 DRIVER PROTOCOL FOR MANIFESTS 3/23/20

1. To reduce the spread and transmission of COVID-19, Colorado Medical Waste drivers will no longer be required to have customers sign manifests.
2. If available, the driver will ask for the name of the person that would sign the manifest and will write it in themselves.
3. If someone is not available, please put **NSA** which stands for (No Signature Available) in the generator name.
4. Leave a pink copy as proof of service.
5. This COVID-19 emergency response procedure will be implemented effective immediately 3/23/20 to reduce possible transmission.
6. Entering areas where sick patients are and where signatures are frequently obtained, especially in high risk facilities such as nursing homes and long-term care facilities will reduce exposure to staff and customers.
7. Medical waste containers should be placed in non-public storage areas. Full sharps containers and medical waste shall be placed in Colorado Medical Waste containers.
8. Biohazard liners shall be tied by the generator in compliance with OSHA regulations. Lids shall snap and close securely for transport.
9. Clean and sanitized containers will replace those that are picked up along with biohazard liners for each container.
6. Any customers that are generating COVID19 waste have been asked to let us know and to label their containers so our drivers and warehouse workers can take additional safety precautions when handling.
